Listed below are the current NARIGC committees available to join.

Member Engagement Committee: The Member Engagement Committee directs and develops Chapter education and social programs outside of our signature annual events. These strategic visionaries monitor progress, marketing, and promotion of Chapter events, ensuring we align with our strategic growth plan.

Remodeler of the Year (ROTY) Awards Committee: The ROTY Awards Committee oversees and facilitates the marketing, submission, review, and judging of the ROTY award applications.
